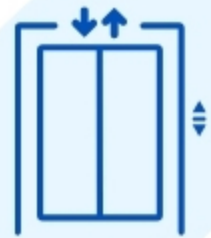




# WHY ELEVATOR SYSTEMS FAIL IN MODERN BUILDINGS

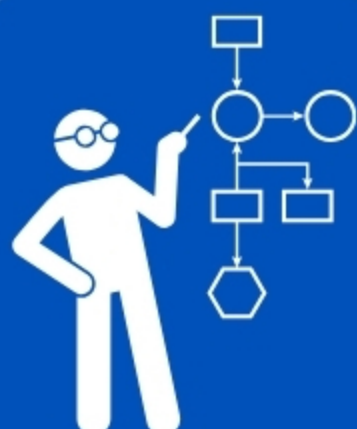

### THE PROBLEM AT A GLANCE

- Unsolved Complaints – No clear data to explain the issues.

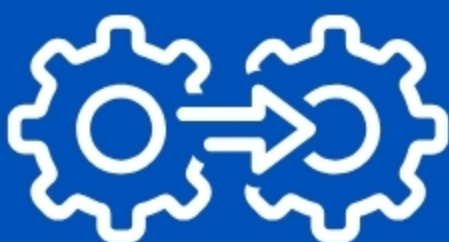
